My Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday we commemorate the beautiful Church celebrations of All Saints and All Souls. We remember the Saints and their power to pray for us as we continue our earthly journey. We also remember all those whom we have loved and lost. They have passed through our lives, and then have passed on to eternal life. As Catholics, we believe that we are able to pray for them, and pray to them, in the great company of heaven which we call the "Communion of Saints". We believe that they are in the "hands of God", but we long to have them close at hand - hand in hand with us. There will be two opportunities to attend an All Soul's Mass:

Sunday, November 1st at 7:00 pm – Vigil Mass for All Soul's at Sacred Heart

Monday, November 2nd at 7:00 pm – Mass of the Day for All Soul's at St. Joseph

At this time of the year, it is always good for us to recall the Church's beautiful and merciful teaching on Purgatory. I refer to the teaching on Purgatory as both "beautiful" and "merciful" - and for good reason. All of us have probably known, or will have known someone who has died and who has struggled with serious sin and weakness in their lifetime. In other words, they have not led the most holy or ideal life. How incredibly merciful the teaching on Purgatory is then, because it affirms that God allows us to go through a state of purification before we reach the eternal banquet of heaven. We believe that the souls in Purgatory know that they will inherit the Kingdom of Heaven. We can indeed, pray for and to, these people as well.

On this Feast of All Saint's and All Soul's, as a people of hope, we pray and exclaim:
